KSI Casualty Rates: Casualty Rate Trend 2000 - March 2012 and Projection to 2020

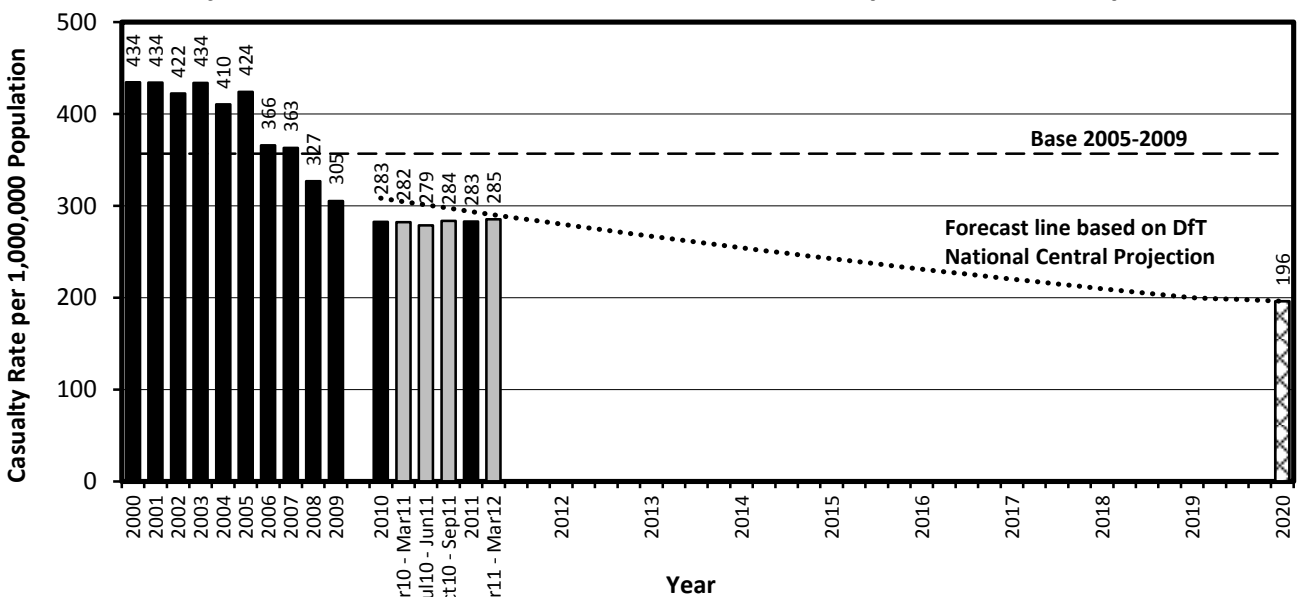
