KSI Casualty Rates: Casualty Rate Trend 2000 - September 2013 and Projection to 2020

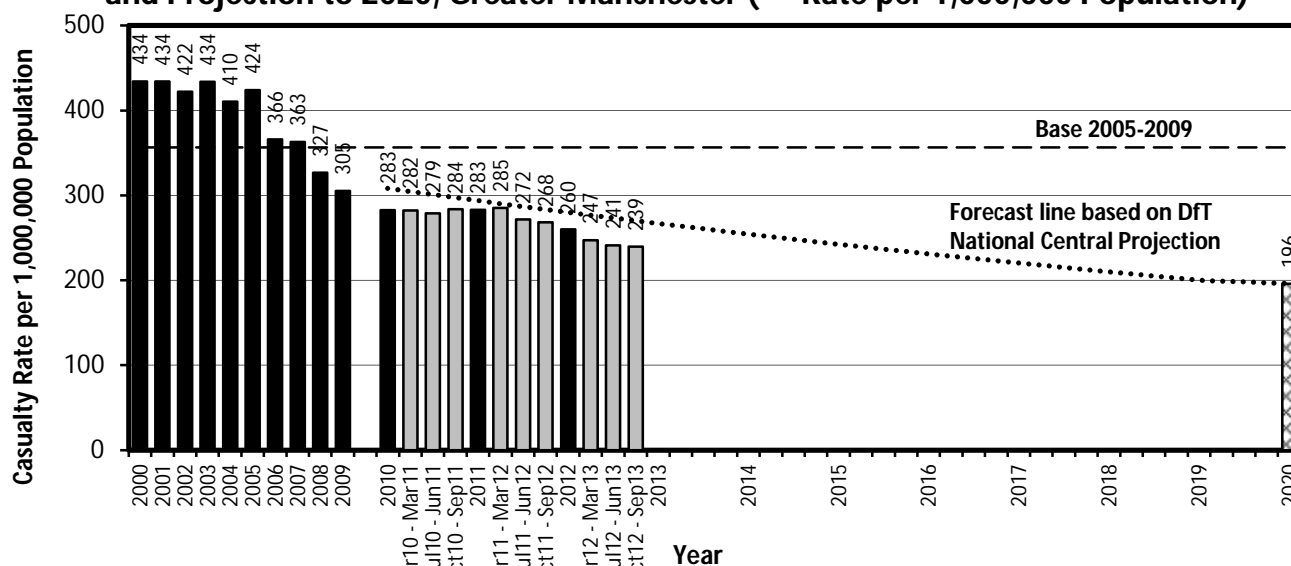
